Reminder, per rule support documents: Provider Risk Management Strategies (PRMS), Safety Plan, Protocols, etc... Need to be prepared and sent to the county by the receiving provider **before** a new entry into your home and prior to the ISP annually after.

Currently we have over 400 vacancies in the metro area, remember to market your home accordingly and make it an appealing choice to individuals considering yoru home.

Make sure DRC's statewide have up to date information on your home and vacancies by completing the <u>Provider Profile and Vacancy form</u>.

Annual ISP & Support Document training
