- 1. Interviewed Meg Robinson and Karen Bjorklund, who applied for the vacant CCI position
- 2. Approval of meeting minutes
  - o Brent Parries moved to approve the minutes as written. Rick seconded, all in favor
- 3. Old business and review of past action items
  - Web Cameras PGA will test cameras on September 8
  - Inactive CPOs County suggested that interested CPOs be paired with inactive CPOs to receive land use notices. CCI members shared their disagreement with this approach. Chris recommended inviting Jennifer Hughes with DTD to the next CCI meeting. Karen suggested to have more CPO members attend the next meeting that Jennifer Hughes attends.
  - Code Enforcement CCI had asked if complaints from CPOs could be prioritized by the county. Per Chris from Code enforcement, the county prioritizes complaints based on the nature of the complaint, rather than where the complaints originate. Brent requested that this issue be elevated to the Board. Chris to check with Code Enforcement about relevant state laws/rules that may dictate what the county is able to do.
- 4. Review new action items and September meeting agenda build
  - Rick suggested ways to educate the community about CPOs Martin and Bill agreed to work with Rick on ways to do this.
  - Coalition of Committees of Color discussed next steps on meeting with CPOs and Hamlets
- 5. Public Comment
  - Karen raised the issue of who is listed as the contact for the inactive CPO Land Use notifications. Chris shared that the contact has recently been updated with a relevant staff contact.
- 6. CCI members convened in executive session to deliberate applicants
  - Reconvened in public session
    - Members voted to recommend Karen Bjorklund, with six in favor of her and one in favor of Meg Robinson.
