WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING FROM THE BOARD?

This is an informational presentation with no action expected.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

On January 16, 2011, the Sandy River left its banks and flooded the area around Lolo Pass Road and the Zigzag River (Lolo Pass Road) Bridge. County crews responded rapidly and immediately started working to restore access for more than 200 residents to their homes. Because of the realignment of the river and the level of damage sustained, the County notified the Oregon Department of State Lands (DSL), the Army Corps of Engineers ("the Corps"), the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW). In addition, once the area was covered under a State Emergency Declaration, the County worked with the Federal Emergency Management Administration (FEMA) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

This presentation is intended to recount the timeline of work that was completed by the County and the ongoing interaction that we have with our State and Federal partners in the repair and restoration of the Lolo Pass Road area.
