STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. - 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Jennifer Kauppi, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent's mailing address is: 8801 SE 307TH Ave, Boring, OR 97009.

2.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is: 8801 SE 307th Ave, Boring, OR 97009 also known as T1S, R4E, Section 29B, Tax Lot 02200, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 25th day of March 2024 the Respondents violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Respondents violated the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance, Section 316.03 (A) by operating Translite LLC trucking company, storing commercial vehicles and repair without land use approval. This violation is a Priority 2 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondents in the following manner: Administrative Citation #2400049-1 in the amount of \$400.00 was mailed via first class mail on March 25, 2024. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit E, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter.

Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

- 1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to immediately abate the violation and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondents from violating these laws in the future;
- 2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondents for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for a Zoning and Development Ordinance Priority 2 violation being \$500.00 to \$2,500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;
- 3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code;

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4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

History of Events and Exhibits:

February 27, 2024 Clackamas County received a complaint regarding a commercial trucking

business and repair and storing commercial vehicles onsite without land use

approval.

February 27, 2024 I researched the code enforcement history of the subject property. Since Exhibit A 2017, this case is the 8th code enforcement violation opened for operating a

commercial trucking business, storing commercial vehicles and commercial truck repair onsite without land use approval. The first file was opened in 2017. At that time Dmitriy and his son came into the office and spoke with code enforcement regarding the violation. Dimitriy stated he would stop parking commercial vehicles on the subject property and the case was closed. In 2019 another complaint was received and a Notice of Violation was sent to the Respondents. The Respondent again stated that the business had ceased on the property. In 2020, two additional complaints were received and the Respondents were issued citations 2000336-1 for \$75.00 and 2000336-2 for 400.00. Another complaint was filed in 2021 and 2 additional

complaints in 2022. Citation 2200210 for \$400.00 was issued for file

V0021022 and was paid in December 2022.

March 7, 2024 Photos were received into the County regarding the commercial activity

Exhibit B onsite.

March 11, 2024 I conducted a site inspection and confirmed the violation exists on the

Exhibit C subject property.

March 12, 2024 Photos were received into the County showing the continued activity on the

Exhibit D subject property. These photos were taken on March 12, 2024.

March 25, 2024 Exhibit E On March 19, 2024 Citation 2400049 for \$500.00 was issued for the Priority 2 land use violation. On March 25, 2024 I reviewed this file and notice the error in the fine amount for that Citation. I voided Citation 2400049 and reissued Citation 2400049-1 for \$400.00 for the Priority 2 land use violation. The citation was sent first class mail and was not returned to the County. The citation has not been paid.

April 3, 2024

I received a call from the owners son Ruvim. He was asking about the citation that his parents received. I explained that this was the 8th code enforcement case for the same land use violation and that a hearing would be scheduled.

April 22, 2024

Code Enforcement referred this matter to the Hearings Officer.

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the Zoning and Development Ordinance, Title 12, Section 316.03, the County is requesting a Final Order in this matter recommending the following:

- The Respondents be ordered to immediately cease operating the commercial trucking business, repair or storing commercial vehicles onsite. All commercial vehicles shall be removed from the subject property within 72 hours of the Final Order.
- If the Respondent wishes to operate a commercial business onsite, the Respondents will obtain an approved land use decision and meet the conditions of approval before any business activities including storing of commercial vehicles occurs on the subject property.
- The report may include the following recommendations:
- The imposition of civil penalties for the Zoning violation of up to \$2,500.00 for date cited March 25, 2024.
- Payment for Citation 2400049-1 in the amount of \$400.00.
- Administrative Compliance fee in the amount of \$75.00.
- The County requests the Hearings Officer to permanently prohibit the Respondents from violating this law in the future.
- If the Respondents fail to comply with the Hearings Officer's Final Order the County will request the Hearings Officer to issue a Final Order and will also request the Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.

Dan called and we discussed the allegations. Dan said there is an old house on the property that is in poor condition and that they want to construct a new dwelling to replace it. Dan said they were parking the trucks there for a while until they decide what to do. Dan was very evasive when asked questions. I explained the zoning rules that prohibit the parking of trucks over 11K GVW without an approved home occupation permit. Dan said that Dimitriy does not live on the property full time because of the poor condition of the house on site. I told Dan that if Dimitry does not live on site, he could qualify for a home occupation permit and therefore cannot park any trucks on site. Dan said that he would speak with father about how to proceed from here and will probably come into have me explain the rules to his father in person.

This office received a complaint that a commercial business has been operating on the subject property. During an office meeting on March 27th 2019, Dmitriy admitted at least one commercial vehicle has been parked on the site for his business "Diesel Logistics LLC."

The subject property is currently zoned RRFF5 (Rural Area Residential Farm Forest 5-Acre). In this zone, home occupations are allowed subject to the performance standards and permit requirements set forth in Title 12.822 of the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance. A recent review of County records finds no such permit has been issued for this use. To abate this zoning violation you must comply with Title 12.315.030.

It is requested that one (1) of the following alternatives be utilized **no later than** 4/29/2019:

- 1. Cease the unauthorized use or;
- 2. Contact the County Planning Department and submit an application for a Home Occupation Permit. If you fail to obtain land use approval, you will need to cease the unauthorized use.

If you have any questions concerning these permit requirements, please contact the Planning Division at 503-742-4500. Or you may stop by the Planning, Permitting and Code Enforcement offices at the Development Services Building, 150 Beavercreek Road, Oregon City. The lobby is open between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Fridays.

Required Notice of Fines and Penalties

It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, (2) assessment of a \$75 per month administrative compliance fee, and (3) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

The Clackamas County Code provides for fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.

Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.

Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.

Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.

Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
