

The 2011 Clackamas County Fair

1. Purpose – The Fair Board and staff's dedication and purpose is to provide a showplace for educational activities, healthful competition, and recognition of our County youth, agriculture, business, commerce, history and tourism
2. Attendance – 134,124 citizens attended or participated in the fair. This is an increase of 5% from last year.
3. Non-Profit Group – Fifty-five non-profit groups participated in the fair
4. Volunteerism – On Saturday August 6th there was over 200 volunteers setting up various areas of the fair.
5. Survey – some of the comments included: that we are the best fair in the state, the Rodeo was excellent, the Fair food is great and that we are a smoke free fair.
6. Facility Rentals – We are more than just a fair. This past year facility rental increased 15%.
7. Main Lawn Restroom Complex – new construction is underway.
8. Agri-Tourism Partnership – The Fair Board is working with Mary Stewart on ways to promote Agri-tourism.
9. County Tourism Partnership – The tourism is helping to fund our Master Plan.
