Shall Vector District renew levy \$0.025 per \$1,000.00 assessed value for preventing mosquito-borne diseases, mosquito-fly control, general operations, capital projects?

Summary 175 words

This measure authorizes the District to renew its levy of \$0.025 per \$1,000.00 assessed value outside its existing permanent rate each year for five years beginning 2015-2016.

This levy will provide funding for finding and controlling the mosquitoes that cause mosquito-borne diseases, maintenance, general operations, and capital projects including:

- * Funding for potential outbreak of mosquito-borne diseases
- * Continued mosquito and fly control services throughout the County

Estimated tax would cost the owner of a home with an assessed value of \$200,000.00 about \$5.00 per year. Tax is subject to the local government rate limit of Section 11b, Article X1 of the Oregon Constitution.

The proposed rate will raise approximately \$998,820.00 in 2015-2016, \$1,023,791.00 in 2016-2017, \$1,049,386.00 in 2017-2018, \$1,075,621.00 in 2018-2019, and \$1,102,512.00 in 2019-2020 for a total of \$5,250,130.00.

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Ballot Measure

Renew Five year local option Levy for Vector (Mosquito-Fly) Control

Clackamas County Vector Control District is responsible for the control of mosquitoes and flies in Clackamas County. District's programs help protect the health of people and animals by limiting the spread of mosquito-borne diseases such as encephalitis, West Nile Virus and other mosquito-borne diseases.

The District hopes to renew the local option Levy rate of \$0.025 per \$1,000 of assessed value. For example, the owner of a home with an assessed value of \$100,000 will pay about \$2.50 per year. The owner of a home with an assessed value of \$200,000 will pay about \$5.00 per year. This is the same rate requested in 2004 and 2009.

This is not a permanent rate. This is only for five years and will expire in 2019.

Continued funding will maintain mosquito and fly control programs at their current levels. Details of District operations can be found at the District's website –FighttheBites.com
