STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. The Hearings Officer for Clackamas County is:

- 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Diane Bautista, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent's mailing address is: 40904 SE Fall Creek Rd., Estacada, OR 97023.

2.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is: 40792 SE Fall Creek Rd., Estacada, OR 97023, also known as T4S, R5E, Section 06, Tax Lot 01100, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 10th day of May, 2023 Respondents violated the following law, in the following way:

a. The Respondents violated the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance,

Title 12 by having an occupied recreational vehicle on site without land use approval.

This violation is a Priority 2 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation

Priorities.

Page 1 of 3 – COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING File No. $\,$ V0005923

On or about the 13th day of September, 2023 Respondents violated the following

law, in the following way:

a. Respondents violated the Clackamas County Solid Waste and Waste Management Code,

Chapter 10.03 by accumulating inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles, boats and

miscellaneous debris. This violation is a Priority 4 violation pursuant to the Clackamas

County Violation Priorities.

4.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the

Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violations was given to Respondents in the following manner: Citation

and Complaint #2300059 in the amount of \$400.00 was mailed via first class mail on May 10, 2023

and Citation and Complaint #2300059-2 in the amount of \$200.00 was mailed via first class mail on

September 25, 2023. A copy of the notice documents is attached to this Complaint as Exhibits E

and H, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter.

Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to

immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and

permanently enjoining Respondents from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty

against Respondents for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County

Commissioners. Said range for a Zoning Ordinance Title 12 Priority 2 violation being \$500.00 to

\$2,500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code; and said

range for Solid Waste and Waste Management, Chapter 10.03 Priority 4 violation being \$100.00 to

\$1,000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;

3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to pay

an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code;

Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to

reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or

fees that may be imposed:

Clackamas County received a complaint regarding occupied recreational

February 16, 2023 Exhibit A	Correspondence was sent to the Respondents regarding the potential zoning code violation.
March 22, 2023 Exhibit B	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed an occupied recreational vehicle, miscellaneous debris and inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles.
March 30, 2023 Exhibit C	Correspondence was sent to the Respondents mailing address and the site address for the zoning and solid waste code violations with a deadline of April 30, 2023.
May 10, 2023 Exhibit D	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed an occupied recreational vehicle, miscellaneous debris and inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles remained on site.
May 10, 2023 Exhibit E	Citation 2300059 was issued for \$400.00 for the zoning ordinance violation. This citation was sent via first class mail and was not returned to the County. This citation remains unpaid.
May 16, 2023	Both Ramona and her grandson Jason left me voice messages. I returned the call to Ramona's phone number and Jason answered. His grandfather recently passed and he moved back to help his grandmother. He said currently he, his mother and uncle are living with his grandmother and the recreational vehicle was occupied by his uncle's girlfriend's daughter named Missy but she is no longer living in the RV. He also stated he had removed (5) cars and has already taken a couple loads to the dump. He said there are (4) cars on site that he doesn't know how to get rid of because no one will take them due to the fact that they were in the fires and the vin numbers are burnt off.

May 24, 2023 – July 25, 2023 Exhibit F	I received pictures from Jason on his progress to abate the solid waste code violation.
September 13, 2023 Exhibit G	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed the miscellaneous debris and inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles remained on site. I could not confirm the recreational vehicle was occupied.
September 25, 2023 Exhibit H	Citation 2300059-2 was issued for \$200.00 for the solid waste code violation. This citation was sent via first class mail and was not returned to the County. This citation remains unpaid.
November 27, 2023 Exhibit I	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed the miscellaneous debris and inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles remained on site. I could not confirm the recreational vehicle was occupied.
November 28, 2023 – December 4, 2023 Exhibit J	I received pictures from Jason on his progress to abate the solid waste code violation.
January 2, 2024 Exhibit K	I conducted a site inspection and confirmed miscellaneous debris, and inoperable and non-currently licensed vehicles and boats. During this inspection I also confirmed an occupied recreational vehicle that had smoke coming out of the chimney and a semi-trailer had been brought onto the site.
January 8, 2024	The County referred this matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position by a preponderance of the evidence, the County may request a Continuing Order in this matter recommending the following:

- The Respondents be ordered to bring the property into compliance with the Clackamas County Solid Waste and Waste Management Code within 30 days of the Continuing Order.
 - Remove or screen all solid waste, including but not limited to equipment and furniture; vehicle parts; tires; scrap metal, or any other useless, unwanted or discarded material, or other similar non-putrescible solid waste or waste that is visible from the road or surrounding properties.
 - o Remove the inoperable and/or not currently licensed vehicles and boats or render them, operable and licensed to persons currently residing on the subject property. Screen no more than two (2) vehicles from view of the road and surrounding properties.

The Respondents be ordered to bring the property into compliance with the Clackamas County Zoning Ordinance within 30 days of the Continuing Order.

- Vacate the recreational vehicle until such time as land use approval is obtained.
- If the recreational vehicle is operable, currently licensed and registered to the person residing on the subject property, it may remain in stored condition. If you wish to store it on site please provide evidence it meets these conditions and schedule a site inspection to confirm, or;
- Remove the recreational vehicle from the property to an authorized location.
- The Respondent be ordered to bring the property into compliance with the Clackamas County Building Code within 30 days of the Continuing Order.
 - Place the semi-trailer on the ground and complete a Statement of Use stating this trailer will be used for residential storage only, **or**;
 - Remove the semi-trailer from the property to an authorized location.

Code Enforcement to confirm compliance of the above items and the County will submit a Post Hearing Status Report. The Report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondents.

- The report may include the following recommendations:
- The imposition of civil penalties for the zoning ordinance violation of up to \$2,500.00 for date cited May 10, 2023.
- The imposition of civil penalties for the Solid Waste Code violation of up to \$1,000.00 for date cited September 13, 2023.
- Payment for Citation 2300059 for \$400.00 issued on May 10, 2023 and Citation 2300059-2 issued on September 25, 2023 for \$200.00. For a total amount due of \$600.00.
- The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from March 2023 until the violations are abated. As of this report the total amount due is \$675.00.
- The County requests the Hearings Officer to permanently prohibit the Respondents from violating this law in the future.
- If the Respondents fail to comply with the Hearings Officer's Continuing Order the County will request the Hearings Officer to issue a Final Order and will also request the Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.





This letter serves as notice of a violation of the Clackamas County Code. The violations include:

- Occupied recreational vehicle(s)
- Accumulation of solid waste
- Inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles

VIOLATIONS & HOW TO RESOLVE

Occupied Recreational Vehicles

Occupied recreational vehicles constitute a violation of Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance, Title 12, Section 406.04(A). In order to abate the violations, you must complete one of the following **no later than April 30, 2023:**

- Vacate the recreational vehicles until such time as land use approval is obtained.
- If the recreational vehicles are operable, currently licensed and registered to the
 person residing on the subject property, it may remain in stored condition. If you
 wish to store it on site please provide evidence it meets these conditions and
 schedule a site inspection to confirm.

Solid Waste

An accumulation of solid waste constitutes a violation of Solid Waste and Waste Management Code, Title 10, Chapters 10.03.060 (A) and (B), as it provides a condition of unsightliness and is considered a public nuisance. In order to abate the violations, you must complete the following **no later than April 30, 2023:**

 Remove or screen all solid waste, including but not limited to equipment and furniture; vehicle parts; tires; scrap metal, or any other useless, unwanted or discarded material, or other similar non-putrescible solid waste or waste that is visible from the road or surrounding properties.

Additionally all putrescible (household) waste must be stored in a rodent proof container with a tight-fitting lid and removed to an authorized disposal facility a minimum of **once every seven (7) days.** Covering solid waste with a tarp or tarp like structure does not remove the items from violation.

Inoperable and/or Non-Currently Licensed Vehicles

Inoperable and/or non-currently licensed vehicles constitute a violation of Solid Waste and Waste Management Code, Title 10, Chapters 10.03.060 (A) and (B), as it provides a condition of unsightliness and is considered a public nuisance. In order to abate the violations, you must complete the following **no later than April 30, 2023:**

- Remove the inoperable and/or not currently licensed vehicles from the subject property, **and/or**;
- Render the inoperable and/or currently unlicensed vehicles, operable and licensed, and/or;
- Place the inoperable and/or not currently licensed vehicles inside a permitted structure, and/or;
- Screen no more than two (2) vehicles from view of the road and surrounding properties, in accordance with the minimum screening requirements of the code (see Title 10.03.060 (C)). Please note: placing vehicles under tarps or tarp structures does not remedy the violation.

Important Notices

- Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- 2. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
- 3. Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. **Potential Fines and Penalties:** The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property: Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
