

Child Care Deserts

Areas where less than 33.3% of children are able to access child care

- Clackamas County needs:
 - 11,000 Child Care Slots
 - 6,589 Qualified Staff
- 51% of US families live in a Child Care Desert
- 3/5 Rural areas in the US are child care deserts
