These events are for the following eligible Clackamas County residents:

- **Pregnant people**

Pregnant people who become infected with COVID-19 are at higher risk of developing severe disease.

- The CDC and leading pregnancy-related health organizations support COVID-19 vaccination in eligible pregnant people with no contraindications
- Existing data shows no increase in any pregnancy complications following COVID-19 vaccination
- There is preliminary evidence that protection against COVID-19 can transfer from pregnant person to baby after vaccination

After scheduling you will receive a confirmation email for your appointment. Please arrive 10 minutes before your appointment to complete required forms.

Interpreters will be available throughout your visit to assist with the vaccination and any questions.
