Amendment value is \$280,480.96 for six months, agreement value is increased to \$15,682,170.94 for 1.5 years. Funding is through Oregon Health Authority. No County General Funds are involved.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: The Behavioral Health Division of the Health, Housing and Human Services Department requests the approval of Amendment #09 to Intergovernmental Agreement #173129 with the State of Oregon, acting by and through its Oregon Health Authority for the financing and operation of Community Mental Health, Addiction Treatment, Recovery & Prevention Services and Problem Gambling programs in Clackamas County. The Board of Commissioners is the Local Mental Health Authority for Clackamas County that operates a Community Mental Health Program funded by this Agreement. The Behavioral Health Division ensures that the funds are administered according to the terms set forth by this Agreement to provide local administration, behavioral health, and addiction services to Clackamas County.

Amendment #09 impacts one specialized service description funded through this IGA: MHS 25A – Mobile Crisis Intervention Services-Stabilization Services for Children and Their Families. This is new funding starting in 2023 with the focus on expanding child and family expertise on the Clackamas Mobile Response Team and providing up to 56 days of crisis stabilization services for children/youth who otherwise may have needed to go to the hospital. This funding is ongoing, not one-time.

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Amendment #09 adds a total of \$280,480.96 for six months of services expiring June 30, 2023. This Amendment increases the Agreement value to \$15,682,170.94.

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends Board approval of this Amendment.

2022 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE FINANCING OF

PREVENTION, AND PROBLEM GAMBLING SERVICES #173129**

This Ninth Amendment to Oregon Health Authority 2022 Intergovernmental Agreement for the Financing of Community Mental Health, Addiction Treatment, Recovery, & Prevention, and Problem Gambling Services effective as of January 1, 2022 (as amended, the “Agreement”), is entered into, as of the date of the last signature hereto, by and between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Oregon Health Authority (“OHA”) and **Clackamas County** (“County”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, OHA and County wish to modify the Financial Assistance Award set forth in Exhibit C of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, covenants and agreements contained herein and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

1. The financial and service information in the Financial Assistance Award are hereby amended as described in Attachment 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. Attachment 1 must be read in conjunction with the portion of Exhibit C of the Agreement that describes the effect of an amendment of the financial and service information.
2. County represents and warrants to OHA that the representations and warranties of County set forth in section 4 of Exhibit F of the Agreement are true and correct on the date hereof with the same effect as if made on the date hereof.
3. Except as amended hereby, all terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect.
4. This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, all of which when taken together shall constitute one agreement binding on all parties, notwithstanding that all parties are not signatories to the same counterpart. Each copy of this Amendment so executed shall constitute an original.
