STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

1. **Prior to the Hearing.** You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
2. **Procedure.** The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
3. **Record of Proceedings.** An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
4. **Hearings Officer.** The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officer's Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. 5. **Right to Recess.** If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
6. **Right to Appeal.** The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Andrea Hall, Senior Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent Eloy Sepeda-Fernandez mailing address is: 18077 S Dillman Rd.,
Oregon City, OR 97045.

2.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is:
18077 S Dillman Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, also known as T3S, R3E, Section 6C , Tax Lot 1306,
and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 28th day of July, 2017 and on June 3, 2024 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Chapter 9.03 of the Clackamas County Code as it pertains to Grading and Excavating.

This violation is a Priority One violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation
Priorities.

4.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner: Violation Notice and Citation and Complaint #1600143. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibits D & G, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter.

Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for the Priority One violation being \$750.00 to \$3500.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code;

3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code; and

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

5. Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

STATEMENT OF PROOF

History of Events and Exhibits:

March 9, 2016 Exhibit A	In response to a complaint, a letter was mailed to the Respondent alleging an accumulation of solid waste on the subject property.
May 6, 2016 Exhibit B	A site inspection was attempted but the property was posted no trespassing. The County did an internet search and found evidence that a landscape business was operating from the property.
May 6, 2016 Exhibit C	A letter was sent to the Respondent listing the additional alleged violation.
May 13, 2016	The County spoke with Tim Yocum who is a friend of the property owners regarding a home occupation permit for the business and the fact that aerials suggest grading and filling on site.
July 28, 2017 Exhibit D	A violation notice was sent to the Respondent with a deadline of August 11, 2017 to submit a home occupation permit for the business and a grading permit for the grading work done on the site.
September 26, 2017	The Respondent met with Code Enforcement Specialist Kimberly Benthin at the County and obtained a grading permit application and information regarding the need for a geotech.
March 28, 2018	The County met with the Respondent and Tim at the County. A Home Occupation permit was not an option as he shares an easement with a neighbor who is not willing to sign off on the application. He will scale back to a level one home occupation that is not regulated by the County. The Respondent indicated that he brought material to the property to build up the back of his house as it was placed on a slope. We also met with Plans Examiner Robert Morris who reviewed the aerials and determined that a geotech would be required to draw the plans for the grading permit.

September 9, 2019 Exhibit E	A violation notice regarding the grading violation was sent to the Respondent with a deadline of October 11, 2019 to submit a grading permit application.
April 24, 2020 Exhibit F	An email was sent to the Respondents niece to check to see if there is a plan to abate the grading violation.
June 3, 2024 Exhibit G	Citation number 1600143 was issued in the amount to \$500 for the grading violation. The citation was mailed first class mail and was not returned to the County, the citation remains unpaid.
June 18, 2024 Exhibit H	The County received a request for a hearing from the Respondent.
June 26, 2024	The County referred the matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the Grading and Excavating Code exists on the subject property, the County would request a Continuing Order be issued requiring the Respondent to submit a technically complete grading permit application within 30 days of the date of the Order, comply with any requests for additional information within 10 days and obtain an approved final inspection within 30 days of the date the permit is issued. .

The County will submit a timely Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:

- Payment of Citation 1600143 for \$500.00
 - The imposition of civil penalties of up to \$3500.00
 - The administrative compliance fee imposed from July 28, 2017 totals \$7200.00 however the County is requesting a reduced fee of \$2250.00 as a reasonable estimate of the cost of this enforcement matter.
- If the violations are not abated the County may request authorization for further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.
 - The County requests the Hearing's Officer to permanently enjoin the Respondent from violating these laws in the future.

As you know, it has come to the attention of the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section that there may be an accumulation of solid waste on the above referenced property, specifically, landscape and yard debris. Additionally, per the Oregon Secretary of State's Office, a clean-up and landscape business is operating from the property. A review of County records revealed that there is no land use approval for the business. Aerial photographs of the property revealed that fill material has been placed on the property. There is no record of a grading permit on file with the County.

This constitutes a violation of Chapter 10.030.030 of the Clackamas County Code and Section 316 of the Clackamas County Zoning and Development Ordinance and Chapter 9.03 of the Clackamas County Code as it pertains to Excavation and Grading.

In order to abate the violations, please submit a Home Occupation permit application and a grading permit application, technically complete plans and appropriate fees **not later than August 11, 2017**. The grading permit must be picked up within ten days of being notified. Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of the permit being issued.

Hi Arianne,

I'm a little confused by your message. Your uncle has retained a geo-tech company to work on the project and has asked the County to delay enforcement until the Spring when his business picks up and he would have the funds to move forward with the project. Per the geo-tech who was on site with your Uncle, it is unlikely that the fill material will be able to remain due to the fact that it is not clean fill that has concrete and other debris mixed in.
