WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING FROM THE BOARD?

Staff requests approval of the 2019 Small Grants Recommendations.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Clackamas County Board of Commissioners approved \$250,000 in the 2019/20 FY budget to fund the 2019 Small Grants Program, a decrease of \$50,000 from the previous year. This is the 11th year of the program. The goal is to support agencies that are making an effort to develop and implement innovative projects that would help the County's most vulnerable families, seniors, and others meet their basic needs such as food assistance and abuse prevention. This year's priority was given to those projects servicing the Community Prosperity Collaborative areas and preference was given to those who meet the following criteria:

- Prevent occurrence of larger, more dire problems later;
- Save money later through early intervention;
- Serve people throughout the community.

For the 2019 cycle, Administration staff, along with Public and Government Affairs (PGA) and Technology Services worked diligently to increase awareness and ease of use of our website and application process. We continued to use the online application which has demonstrated to be an effective and easy way for organizations to turn in their applications, although we also provided an application if Word format for those organizations that do not have the technology to submit it online.

We received 95 applications for a total request of \$949,951.44. This is a decrease in both applications and total amount requested. Last year there were 111 applications which totaled \$1,140,834.50. Of the 95 applications, 30 were new applicants, equaling 32% new applicants as compared to last year's 43%. A variety of factors could be attributed to the decrease in both number of applications and number of new applicants but nothing concrete was identified at this time.

A committee was formed to review the applications as well as past small grant awards and current funding from other County departments to determine the attached recommendations (attachment 1). The committee included Caroline Hill, Small Grants Coordinator; Tracy Moreland, Commission Policy Advisor; Chris Storey, Water Environment Services Assistant Director; and Rick Gruen, County Parks and Forest Manager.

Information was distributed to committee members in August for review prior to two subsequent meetings on September 16 and September 19. Each application was reviewed and the focus was to make the Community Prosperity Collaborative areas a priority, as advertised, while at the same time ensuring that the monies were dispersed throughout the County and to impact diverse groups.

Today staff is seeking approval from the Board of the recommendations in attachment 1.
