C. If the pedestrian access route passes through a median or island at-grade, is the pass- thru at least 6 feet wide perpendicular to the direction of travel?
D. If the pedestrian access route passes through a median or island at-grade, and the median or island at least 6 feet wide in the direction of travel, is truncated dome provided at back of curb for all pedestrian access routes? (If the median or island is less than 6 feet wide in the direction of travel truncated dome should not be provided.)
E. Is the cross-slope perpendicular to the direction of pedestrian travel not more than 1.5% at any location.
F. When present are truncated dome warning strips for the median or island separated by at least 2 feet?
