Joe Marek, Transportation Safety Program Manager Clackamas County

- Kamrath & Leland are 21-22 on the transportation list for speed zone change investigations.
- Paving projects upcoming: Springwater Rd., Fischers Mill Rd., Haines Rd., BCM, Mulino Rd.
- Chip-seal Projects: Various list of 100+ roads upcoming (list available on Clackamas County's website.
- Beavercreek Rd./Maplelane Rd.: Detection will be restored after construction is complete and the lights will return to normal function.
- Beavercreek Rd. southbound from HWY-213/left turn to Maplelane is a problematic intersection. Joe Marek indicated we need to reach out to City of Oregon City to learn their plans for the future.



- Wilson Rd. Development has 5 REPORTED accidents. Decisions are based on what is formally reported rather than hearsay.
- Oregon is a self-reporting state.
- Reporting is done through DMV in person or website.
 - o When a person is in an accident worth \$2500 (damage), they shall report the crash themselves to DMV.
- Reporting a crash does not mean your insurance agent will be notified. Crash reports made to DMV are not sent to insurance agencies.
- Speed Sign on Beavercreek Rd. will be designed by June 2024, Project bidding is September 2024, completion June 2025.
- Roundabout at Beavercreek/Kamrath/Leland is in conceptual phase (diagram provided) no funding at this time. Tier 2 project.
- Current funding is set through 2027.
- Roundabout/intersection at Holly Lane/Redland Rd. Project research is based on forecasted construction figures.

 - o Concerns could be stop signs down, malfunctioning traffic signals, trees/debris in roadway, standing water, dead deer/animal, sidewalk tripping hazards, potholes or sink holes, etc.

- b. Ordinance ZDO-288 Zoning & Development Ordinance Amendments Related to Utility Facilities.
 - i. Jessica Sernach and Bill Merchant recuse themselves from further conversation and comment due to conflict of interest.
 - ii. Hamlet will provide feedback on this ZDO on behalf of its members.
 - iii. In person attendee (Jeff) expressed his approval of the ordinance indicating it will allow the county to focus on other things.
 - iv. Tammy read aloud a potential draft of what can be provided as feedback on this ordinance. Feedback was provided by various Board and community members.
- c. ZDO-285 Minor & Time Sensitive Amendments and New Housing Options
 - i. Part one of this ZDO is to allow ADU's outside the UGB and Reserve on rural residential lots of 2 or more acres.
 - ii. Part two of this ZDO would allow Recreational Vehicles (RVs) to be used as residences outside the UGB and Reserve on rural residential lots of 2 or more acres.
 - iii. Tammy read aloud a potential draft of what can be provided as feedback on this ordinance. Feedback provided by various Board and community members.
