What is a CPO???

A CPO is short for Community Planning Organization. Many years ago Oregon passed a law for people who lived in the unincorporated areas of the state and needed representation to their County government regarding land-use issues. This includes zone changes, changes in commercial, industrial, and multi-family buildings – for both new and remodeling projects.

S.U.N. & W.M.S. CPO represents all unincorporated area residents from I-205 on the west; the bluff above 212/224 on the south; SE 142 Ave. on the lower SE area or Happy Valley city boundary on the upper SE area; and Clatsop Street on the north. Mixed in this entire area are individual residents and businesses that have chosen to annex into the city of Happy Valley.

At this time, the CPO meets three times a year on the first Monday in the months of February, June, and October at the above address. There may be changes to these dates if members want changes made to the Bylaws.
