STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. - 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

I, Kimberly Benthin, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondents mailing address is: 14633 SE Brightwood Ave., Milwaukie, OR 97267.

2.

The address or location of the violations of law alleged in this Complaint is: 14633 SE Brightwood Ave., Milwaukie, OR 97267, also known as T2S, R2, Section 08BB, Tax Lot 03724, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 24th day of June 2024, AND on or about the 5th day of August 2024, the Respondents violated the following laws, in the following ways:

Respondents violated Title 9.02 of the Clackamas County Code, Application and

Enforcement of the Clackamas County Building Code by failing to obtain permits and inspections for the construction/remodel of the residence on the above referenced property.

This violation is a Priority 1 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities.

4.

The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondents in the following manner: Violation notice dated June 24, 2024 and Administrative Citation #24218-1. A copy of the notice documents are attached to this Complaint as Exhibits D and F, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter. Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondents from violating these laws in the future;

2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondents for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for the Title 9.01 Priority 1 violations being \$750.00 to \$1,000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code; and

Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering
 Respondents to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the
 Clackamas County Code; and

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondents to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

History of Events and Exhibits:

May 24, 2024	Clackamas County received a complaint that exterior staircases were being constructed without permits.
May 28, 2024 Exhibit: A	Correspondence was mailed to the Respondent.
June 11, 2024 Exhibit: B	A building permit submittal began for "Built 2 emergency egress staircases without permits"
June 24, 2024 Exhibit: C	Facts of the alleged violation were reviewed, the violation verified, and Notice of Violation was mailed requesting permit submittals be completed for all concerns including the exterior stair ways not later than July 24, 2024 The Notice of Violation was mailed via first class mail.
August 1, 2024	Code Enforcement Specialist Benthin performed a site inspection

and confirmed the unpermitted exterior stairs remained on site

without a permit or inspections.

August 5, 2024

Exhibit: E

Citation #24218-1 issued for the building code violation sent via first class mail. The first class mail was not returned. This citation

has not been paid.

Exhibit: F

September 12, 2024 CES Benthin performed a site inspection and confirmed the unpermitted exterior stairs remained on site without a permit or

inspections. Photos were taken.

The County referred this matter to the Code Enforcement Hearings Officer.

If the Hearings Officer affirms the County's position that a violation of the Building Code exists on the subject property, the County would request a Continuing Order be issued requiring the Respondents:

- Submit building, and the accompanying plumbing, mechanical and electrical permit applications, and/or complete the current submittal, for the proposed work and completed work to include but not limited to: Bonus Room conversion to a bedroom with a bathroom, Laundry room converted to staff room, Laundry moved to garage, Foyer living room converted to office. The submittal must include the appropriate fees and all construction documents of sufficient clarity to indicate the location, nature and extent of the work proposed and completed and show in detail that it will conform to the provisions of the Building code and relevant laws:
 - Respond to requests for clarification or additional information from permitting staff within 15 days of receiving such request.
 - The permits must have the fees paid in full within ten days of your being notified by Building Codes in order to prevent delay of the issuance of permits.
 - Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of receipt of your approved permits.

The County will submit a Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:

The imposition of civil penalties of up to \$1000.00 per violation. The administrative compliance fee to be imposed starting from June 2024 until the violations are fully abated.

If the violations are not abated the County may request authorization for further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.

County recommends that reimbursement be ordered for any expense incurred in collection of all penalties, fines and fees.

The County requests the Hearing's Officer to permanently enjoin the Respondent from violating these laws in the future.

This is in follow up to a complaint of construction of exterior stairs on the above referenced property without benefit of permits and inspections.

It was noted that after the correspondence sent May 28, 2024, permit submittal was made by applicant Mike Montgomery. Permit # B0839124 was for "Built 2 emergency egress staircases without permits".

During the review of the submittal documents, the original 1999 plans and the structure's permit history it was found that there are items that must be addressed including but not limited to:

- Second floor shows the bonus room has been converted to a bedroom with a bathroom, no permit records.
- Laundry room converted to staff room, no permit records.
- Laundry moved to garage, no permit records.
- The once foyer/living area is now converted to an office, no permit records.

The above scopes of work will need to be addressed with building, mechanical, electrical and plumbing permits. A count of beds and bedrooms of the plans for this structure is not clear. If there are six beds this permit needs to be resubmitted as a commercial permit.

The unpermitted construction and modifications is a violation of Chapter 9.02 of the Clackamas County Code as it pertains to the Application and Enforcement of the Clackamas County Building Code.

In order to abate the Building Code violations, please complete one of (or a combination of) the following options **not later than July 24, 2024:**

- Please submit, or have your professional submit, building permit application(s), or complete the current submittal, appropriate fees(s) and all construction documents of sufficient clarity to indicate the location, nature and extent of the work proposed and completed and show in detail that it will conform to the provisions of the Building code and relevant laws:
 - Respond to requests for clarification or additional information from permitting staff within 15 days of receiving such request.
 - The permit(s) must have the fee(s) paid in full within ten days of your being notified by Building Codes in order to prevent delay of the issuance of permits.
 - Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of receipt of your approved permit(s). <u>Or:</u>
 - Submit an application for a demolition permit. Please be advised that if you choose to remove unpermitted construction/structures you may still be required to get permits to confirm remaining construction and utilities were removed, or remain in compliance with the codes.
 - The permit(s) must have the fee(s) paid in full within ten days of your being notified by Building Codes.
 - Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of receipt of your approved permit(s).
 - Please call this office to schedule an inspection to confirm removal of structure and all debris.

The submitted permit documents will be subject to the review and approval of the Planning and Zoning Division. The construction and use must meet the requirements and standards of the zoning district applied to the subject property. - 1. Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- 2. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
- Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. **Potential Fines and Penalties:** The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property: Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
