

65th Ave / Elligsen Road / Stafford Road Intersection Improvements

Clackamas County

Partners: Washington County, City of Wilsonville

Project description

Eliminate heavy congestion and improve safety by replacing two failing stop-controlled intersections with a single roundabout, including bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

Community benefits

- Provide more reliable connection for fast-growing urban areas and freight traveling between Clackamas County, Washington County, Tualatin and Wilsonville
- Improve safety for all users
- Add new bicycle and pedestrian facilities
- Reduce congestion at one of the most congested intersections in Clackamas County, with daily afternoon backups often extending more than a ½-mile
- Eliminate up to 15 minutes of delay in travel time

Community support

- Roundabout proposal has strong public support from intersection study.
- Location identified as a priority need by Clackamas County, Washington County and the City of Wilsonville.
