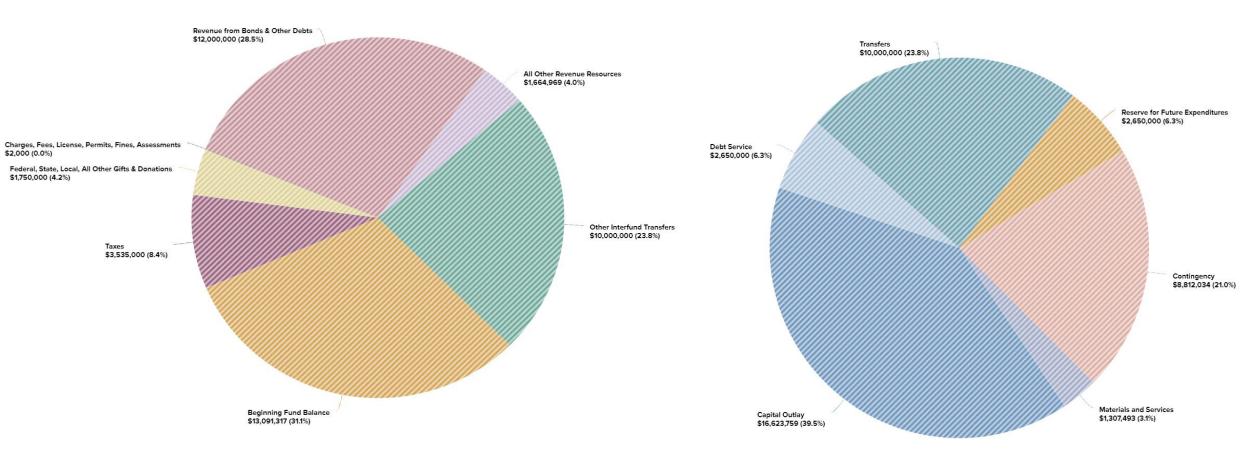

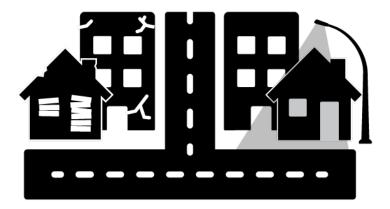

Significant Policy and/or Financial Issues

DESCRIPTION	IMPACT		
A \$12 million bond is anticipated to be issued for the North Clackamas Revitalization Area to help support the eight NCRA projects in various stages of design, right of way acquisition and construction.	Bond proceeds will be used to design and construct several projects within the NCRA district.		
 Design: Linwood, Monroe, SE 79th Intersection, Johnson Creek Park, Hawthorne Park, Johnson Creek Bridge, Area Drainage Improvements. Right of Way: Linwood and Monroe Construction: Fuller Road Station Area 			
 Limited funds remain in the Clackamas Town Center District area. The requested Clackamas Town Center Operating Fund budget will provide \$4.15 million for construction of the Clackamas Regional Center (CRC) Mobility Improvement Project. The CRC project improves the roadway, drainage, lighting, landscaping and intersections on Harmony Road and Sunnyside Road from Fuller Road to 101st Avenue. 	No other projects will be initiated in this district until redevelopment properties owned by the Development Agency are sold.
