RE: Clackamas Addictions Recovery Summit Update

**REQUEST:** The purpose of this update is to confirm the Board's priorities for their meeting with the panelists at the Clackamas Addictions Recovery Summit in September.

**BACKGROUND:** As stated at the July 25 Issues session, the panelists will be meeting separately with the Commissioners. In order to ensure the Summit focuses on the Board priorities, I asked Commissioners and their Policy Advisors to send me their top areas of interest.

I've taken the liberty of organizing all input into three areas:

## Policies, Programs, and Services

- What are the components of a recovery system of care?
  - O What are we doing well? What are the gaps?
  - O What existing services and programs should we be building on?
  - How should we go about matching our resources to what's needed?
  - o What are evidence-based practices that we should be implementing?
- What are best practices and lessons learned from other jurisdictions?
- What policies should we be considering?
- Where/how does employment fit into this picture?
- What's involved with developing a recovery campus/center? It is feasible what works and what doesn't?
- What's on the horizon around innovative treatment and policies for preventing addiction and homelessness that we should be considering now?
