Douglas Fir Tree

This Douglas Fir tree is on the McKrill property located in a heavily wooded area near Kellogg Creek

The trees in this area were planted by the previous owner, Wes Cook, to ensure the area remained well-stocked with timber. A majority of the tree stands are likely a product of a planting in the 1940s.

A typical Douglas Fir can reach 200 to 250 feet and have a trunk diameter from 4.9 to 6.6 feet. This Douglas Fir is estimated to be 120 feet high.

The Douglas Fir adds to the significant grove of trees in the area and qualifies under the heritage tree collection criteria.
