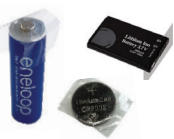

Batteries

Pilas батарейки Bin 电池

1. Prepare



Tape

- Button cells
- Rechargeable
- Lithium/Li-ion
- Battery packs (laptop/cell phone)

Do NOT Tape

- Alkaline (AAA to D)
- Carbon Zinc
- 6- & 9-volt

Single-family residential customers only.

2. Bag all batteries



1qt zip-seal bag

3. Set on top of glass

Garbage

All garbage, including plastic bags, to-go cups & containers, lids & packaging

Motor Oil: Put in a labeled, 2 gal. or less, screw-top container (e.g. milk jug) and set next to glass bin. *Residential only.*

Large Items (appliances, furniture, etc.): Call your garbage and recycling company for special pick-up and pricing.
