## Recycling

**Paper, flattened cardboard, metal, plastic bottles & plastic round containers**  
Empty & dry. Plastic items must be 2x2 inches or larger.



## Glass

In separate  
glass bin

**Bottles & jars only**  
empty & dry, no lids

Missing a glass bin? Call your garbage & recycling company.



## Batteries

Pilas Батарейки Bin 电池

1. Tape ends of all batteries,  
except alkaline  
use clear tape,  
household batteries only

2. Bag all batteries  
in a 1 qt. zip-seal bag

3. Set on top of glass in the glass bin

Single-family residential customers only.



## Yard Waste\*

**Leaves, grass, small branches, plants & trimmings**

\*Urban areas only. Cities of Lake Oswego, Milwaukie, and Wilsonville can include food scraps.



## Garbage

Basura Mycop Rác còn lại 垃圾



**All garbage, including plastic bags, to-go cups & containers, lids & packaging**

**Motor Oil:** Put in a labeled, 2 gal. or less, screw-top container (e.g. milk jug) and set next to glass bin. *Residential only.*  
**Large Items (appliances, furniture, etc.):** Call your garbage and recycling company for special pick-up and pricing.
