STATEMENT OF RIGHTS

- 1. Prior to the Hearing. You have the right to make the following requests:
 - (A) You can request the opportunity to review public records and to talk to County staff about the violations or request a subpoena for that purpose if the County does not allow you to do so.
 - (B) You can request that the Hearings Officer postpone the hearing for good cause by writing the Hearings Officer at least 7 calendar days prior to the scheduled hearing date.
 - (C) You can request that the Hearings Officer decide the matter based exclusively on written materials from the parties or conduct the hearing by phone.
- 2. Procedure. The hearing will be governed by general rules of procedure designed to allow you to hear and confront the evidence against you, and for you to present evidence favorable to you. You are not required to present any evidence, the burden is on the County to establish by a preponderance of the evidence that a violation exists, or existed. Either party may, at their own expense, obtain an attorney to represent them at the hearing. If you wish to be represented by an attorney they need only notify the County and the Hearings Officer in writing of their intent to appear on your behalf. The County will present evidence first, and then you may question that evidence. You may then present your own evidence, if you wish, and the County may question your evidence. Testimony by witnesses is evidence. The Hearings Officer may inquire into any facts that are relevant to the hearing and may question the parties or witnesses about the case. Evidence of a type commonly relied upon by reasonably prudent persons in the conduct of their serious affairs shall be admissible.
- 3. Record of Proceedings. An audio record will be made of the proceedings when a hearing is conducted. The audio record is available through the Clackamas County Code Enforcement Section and is available to you upon request.
- 4. Hearings Officer. The Hearings Officer is an independent contractor paid by the County to conduct hearings and render decisions. He/she is not a County employee. His/her function is to preside over the hearing, make a record of proceedings, consider admissible evidence, and interpret and apply the law. After the hearing is closed the Hearings Officer will enter written findings of fact, conclusions of law, and any Order deemed proper. If a violation is proven, then the Order may include civil penalties, fines, administrative fees, or may require the respondent to take certain actions, or refrain from certain actions. An Order issued by the Hearings Officer may be a Final Order or Continuing Order. The Hearings Officers Order is the final decision of the County, and may be appealed pursuant to Oregon law. The Hearings Officer for Clackamas County is:

- 5. Right to Recess. If, during the course of the hearing, Respondent or the County requests a recess or postponement, or additional time to present crucial evidence, the Hearings Officer may allow a continuance of the hearing for good cause. The Respondent may also request that the proceeding be continued after the end of the hearing if the Respondent determines that additional evidence should be brought to the attention of the Hearings Officer.
- 6. <u>Right to Appeal</u>. The Final Order of the Hearings Officer shall set forth the right of the respondent to appeal any adverse Order. Appeal may be taken pursuant to Section 2.07.130 of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer Code, and Oregon Revised Statute 34.010-34.100. If appeal is taken, appellant is responsible for all costs of appeal including preparation of transcript.

COMPLAINT AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

I, Jennifer Kauppi, Code Enforcement Specialist for Clackamas County, allege the following:

1.

Respondent's mailing address is: 14543 SE West Park Ct., Damascus, OR 97089.

2.

The address or location of the violation(s) of law alleged in this Complaint is: 14543 SE West Park Ct., Damascus, OR 97089 also known as T2S, R3E, Section 07A, Tax Lot 00125, and is located in Clackamas County, Oregon.

3.

On or about the 6th day of December 6, 2022 the Respondent violated the following laws, in the following ways:

a. Respondent violated the Clackamas County Building Code, Section 9.02.040 by failing to obtain approved permits and approved final inspections for an addition to a deck and deck cover. This violation is a Priority 4 violation pursuant to the Clackamas County Violation Priorities. The Department initiating this procedure is the Code Enforcement Section of the Department of Transportation and Development.

5.

Notice of the violation was given to Respondent in the following manner:

Administrative Citation #2200384 in the amount of \$250.00 was mailed via first class mail on

December 6, 2022. A copy of the notice document is attached to this Complaint as Exhibit D, and incorporated by this reference.

6.

Based on these allegations, petitioner requests that a hearing be set in this matter.

Petitioner seeks an Order from the Hearings Officer granting the following relief:

- 1. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to immediately abate the violations and bring the property at issue into compliance with all laws, and permanently enjoining Respondent from violating these laws in the future;
- 2. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, imposing a civil penalty against Respondent for each violation, within the range established by the Board of County Commissioners. Said range for a Building Code priority 4 violation being \$250.00 to \$1,000.00 per occurrence as provided by Appendix B to the Clackamas County Code.
- 3. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to pay an administrative compliance fee as provided by Appendix A to the Clackamas County Code;

4. Pursuant to Clackamas County Code Section 2.07.090, ordering Respondent to reimburse the County for any expense the County may incur in collection of any penalties, fines or fees that may be imposed:

Ordering any other relief deemed reasonably necessary to correct the violations.

STATEMENT OF PROOF

History of Events and Exhibits:

September 17, 2022	Clackamas County received a complaint regarding an addition to a deck and deck cover built without permits.
October 18, 2022 Exhibit A	I conducted a site inspection. I found a porch cover approximately 450 square feet in size. There was also an addition made to the deck which is over 30 inches in height from the ground.
October 18, 2022 Exhibit B	Correspondence was sent to the Respondent with a deadline of November 18, 2022 to abate the Building Code violation.
November 23, 2022 Exhibit C	I found an email and phone number for the Respondent. I sent the Respondent an email requesting that he contact me regarding the building code violation. The Respondent responded to me stating that he would be removing the deck. I let the Respondent know that a permit is required to remove the structure.
December 6, 2022 Exhibit D	I reviewed County records and found no permit had been submitted for the addition of the deck and deck cover. Citation 2200384 for \$250.00 for the Priority 4 Building Code violation was sent first class mail. The first class mail was not returned. This citation remains unpaid.
January 11, 2023 Exhibit E	I emailed the Respondent requesting he contact me regarding the building code violation. I received no contact back from the Respondent.
January 30, 2023	This matter was referred to the Hearings Officer.

If the Compliance Hearings Officer affirms the County's position by a preponderance of the evidence, the County may request a Continuing Order in this matter recommending the following:

- The Respondent be ordered to bring the property into compliance with the Building Code within 45 days of the date of the order by obtaining all required permits and approved final inspections to keep or remove the addition of the deck and deck cover.
- The County will submit a Post Hearing Status Report. The report will be sent to the Compliance Hearings Officer and to the Respondent. The report may include the following recommendations:
- The imposition of civil penalties for the Building Code violation of up to \$1,000.00 for date cited December 6, 2022.
- Payment for citation 2200384 in the amount of \$250.00 issued on December 6, 2022.
- The administrative compliance fee to be imposed from November, 2022 until the violation is abated. As of this report the total is \$225.00.
- The County requests the Hearings Officer to permanently prohibit the Respondent from violating this law in the future.
- If the Respondent fails to comply with the Hearings Officer's Continuing Order the County will request the Hearings Officer to issue a Final Order and will also request the Hearings Officer to authorize the County further enforcement action including to proceed to Circuit Court.
- If the Compliance Hearings Officer imposes penalties, fines and fees the County would also ask the Hearings Officer to order reimbursement for any expense the County incurs in collection of these monies, per Clackamas County Code Chapter 2.07.090(6).





This letter serves as notice of a violation of the Clackamas County Code. The violations include:

Deck and patio cover built without permits

VIOLATIONS & HOW TO RESOLVE

On October 18, 2022 a site inspection confirmed the deck and patio cover at the above referenced property that is currently being built requires permitting. A review of County records found no permits have been submitted. Constructing a deck over 30 inches in height and a patio cover over 200 square feet without permits constitutes a violation of Clackamas County Code Title 9.02.040 (E). In order to abate the violation(s), you must complete the following **no later than November 18, 2022:**

Patio cover and deck

- Please submit, or have your professional submit, the building permit application(s), technically complete plans and appropriate fee(s). Permits are accepted online only, for more information on this process please refer to the County's website at https://www.clackamas.us/building
 - All requests for additional information regarding plan review must be responded to within 10 days of being notified.
 - The permit(s) must have the fee(s) paid in full within ten days of your being notified by Building Codes.
 - Please schedule all inspections so that final inspections may be obtained not later than 45 days of the date of receipt of your approved permit(s).

<u>Or</u>.

 You may abate the violation by demolishing the patio cover and deck. Please submit an application for a demolition permit. Please be advised that if you choose to remove the structure – you may still be required to get permits to confirm the remaining construction and utilities remain code compliant. All debris must be removed code compliantly.

Important Notices

- Administrative Compliance Fees. It is important that you contact the Code Enforcement Section to resolve the violations described in the enclosed letter. An administration compliance fee of \$75 will now be assessed monthly until the violations are abated.
- 2. Failure to resolve those violations may result in one or more of the following: (1) a citation and fine, and (2) referral of this matter to the County Code Enforcement Compliance Hearings Officer.
- 3. Request for a Hearing: If you dispute the existence of the violations described in the enclosed letter you may request a hearing before the Hearings Officer by sending a written request for a hearing, including your name and address to: Code Enforcement Section, 150 Beavercreek Rd., Oregon City, OR 97045, or at codeenforcement@clackamas.us.
- 4. **Potential Fines and Penalties:** The Clackamas County Code provides for Citation fine amounts of up to \$500 and additional civil penalties imposed by the Hearings Officer of up to \$3,500 for each day the County verifies the noncompliance. Fine amounts and civil penalties may be assessed for each cited violation and may be assessed separately against each named party. In addition, the Hearings Officer may order the violation to be abated by the County at the expense of the property owner(s) and responsible parties.
- 5. **Voluntary Compliance:** Clackamas County encourages voluntary compliance with code violations to support a safe and healthy community for all. Please note that when a property owner works cooperatively with the County to resolve a confirmed code enforcement violation, the County may in its discretion waive all or part of the \$75 per month administrative fee.
- 6. Non-Compliance may result in a lien upon your property: Fines and costs are payable upon the effective date of the final order declaring the fine and costs. Fines and costs under this Chapter are a debt owing to the County, pursuant to ORS 30.460, and may be collected in the same manner as any other debt allowed by law. If fines or costs are not paid within 60 days after payment is ordered, the County may file and record the order for payment in the County Clerk Lien Record.
- 7. **Final Order may be enforced in Circuit Court:** Also, be advised that non-compliance with a Hearings Officer's Order may result in the matter being referred to County Counsel for legal action in Circuit Court which may result in additional penalties or other sanctions.
- 8. **Recurrences will result in additional Citations:** Finally, recurrences of abated violations may result in the issuance of a citation without prior notice.
