Local Public Safety Coordinating Council Meeting

April 25th, 2024 5:00 – 5:30 pm Zoom

Members present: Malcolm McDonald, Mary Rumbaugh, Bruce Tarbox, Adam Freer, Sheriff Angela Brandenburg, District Attorney John Wentworth, Christina McMahan, Chief Shaun Davis, and Rod Cook.

Guests present: Elizabeth White, Chris Chandler, and Dylan Blaylock.

Dylan Blaylock, Public & Government Affairs, hosted the webinar and initiated the meeting. He introduced Malcolm McDonald, Clackamas County Community Corrections Director and LPSCC Chair, and stated the Chair will facilitate the meeting. Dylan confirmed there were no members from the public present.

Welcome/Introductions

Chair Malcolm McDonald called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m and welcomed members and guests.

Action Item – Justice Reinvestment Program (JRP) Second Year Funding Approval

Chair McDonald stated that the primary agenda item was the approval of the second-year funding for the Justice Reinvestment Program (JRP), which supports Community Corrections, the Sheriff's Office, and probation services. He indicated that the application had been sent to all members. The application addressed concerns about an increase in prison usage for property crimes and a lack of decline in overall prison usage. It explained why these issues persisted and outlined collaborative efforts with the District Attorney's office to address them.

The Chair said that the grant typically spans two years, but due to the issues identified by the Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), only one year of funding was initially approved. He noted CJC approval of this application was necessary to secure funding for the second year. The Chair invited questions from the attendees. Upon receiving no questions, the Chair requested a motion to approve the second-year funding. Rod Cook motioned to approve, and Bruce Tarbox seconded the motion. With no "nay" votes from any members present, the vote was unanimous. No objections or further discussions were raised, and the motion was passed.

Consent Agenda – Approval of minutes from March 11th, 2024, October 17th, 2023, & September 11th

Chair McDonald requested a motion to approve all three sets of meeting minutes. District Attorney John Wentworth motioned to approve, and Bruce seconded the motion. With no "nay" votes from any members present, the vote was unanimous. No objections or further discussions were raised, and the motion was passed.
