Using ORPIN to find Clackamas County business opportunities

ORPIN – the Oregon Procurement Information Network – is the state’s #1 resource for viewing public agency contract and business opportunities.

Clackamas County, and most state and local government agencies, use ORPIN to notify vendors of contracting opportunities, post bid and proposal documents and keep proposers up to date on opportunities and contract awards. To be notified of opportunities, vendors must register with ORPIN.

To participate, simply register on ORPIN and then log in to search for opportunities that match your business offerings. Vendors can also sign up for email notifications based on your field of expertise, location and business profile.

How to register with ORPIN

1. Visit ORPIN: <http://orpin.oregon.gov/open.dll/welcome>
2. Click on Supplier Registration in the left-hand menu bar.
3. Follow screen direction.

2. Click on *Browse Opportunities*
3. Click on *By Organization*
4. Select *Issued by*, click *Search*
5. Click *Clackamas County Government (ORCPP)*.
A list of the County’s open opportunities will display.
6. Select the solicitation you are interested in for more bid and proposal documents, important dates and more information.
