Committee Updates	>	 Finance Committee – Mike stated that the Finance Committee did not meet in July as scheduled due to the HRSA Operational Site Visit, which involved discussion of financial business. Ed reported that the budget is projecting a \$900K surplus. 340B Pharmacy program is doing well and other revenue-generating programs are on track. Awaiting final payments before closing the year out.
	a a	 Nominating Committee – Kelli directed the attention of the Council to page 12 of the packet, which lists the 2018-2019 elected officers as well as committee assignments. Staff representation for the committees include Ed Johnson for Finance Committee, James Wilson for QI Committee, and Jeanine Goodwin for Nominating Committee. Kelli opened the floor for members not currently serving on a committee to voice their interest. Celina stated she is interested in serving on the Nominating Committee. Consumer Outreach Plan – Kelli stated that one of the Committee's ideas is to focus on collaborating with clinic staff by hosting luncheons where Council members can network with clinic staff in an informal setting to answer questions and strategize ways to connect patients with the CHC. The consultants from HRSA also made some recruitment suggestions, which the Committee will discuss at its August meeting. Fundamentals of Governance – The Council members that reviewed the webinar stated that the information is useful.

to the HRSA Operational Site Visit July 17-19, but there are nine proposed findings, the highlight of which includes a missed meeting in December 2017, and old language reflected in the CHC bylaws regarding "Loss of Wages" reimbursement for council members. Deborah stated she is happy with the outcome of the survey, and that the official report should be available to the full council by its September meeting. Ed reported that a HRSA Corrective Action Team has been formed. He announced that he will no longer be the point person for reviewing the Council's meeting and committee minutes. The CHC must review their meeting minutes prior to their public distribution. The Council discussed the proposed findings and determined to continue holding regular meetings once per month, including December, and to ensure appropriate recording in the minutes if a meeting is cancelled/rescheduled. The Council also agreed to review their own meeting minutes prior to public distribution, removing the responsibility from FQHC staff. Formal Change in Scope (CIS) Form 5A—Delete column II under "Complementary and Alternative Services (Additional Services), which are services that the Health Center does not pay These services will continue to be provided through cooperative contracts.
