EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:

Currently, the Mayor and City Councilors serve four-year terms on a rotating basis. There is not a limit on the number of terms the Mayor or a City Councilor can serve. This measure is being referred to the voters by the current Mayor and City Council members. If approved, it would limit the total number of terms to any elected position at the City of Happy Valley to five terms. Of those five terms, a person could only serve as Mayor for a total of two terms. An elected or appointed partial term does not count towards those limits. If approved, the term limits in this measure will apply to all existing and future Mayors and City Council members.
