

All visits are monitored and subject to recording.

Inmate Video Visitation

The Clackamas County Jail's top priority is the safety and security of everyone in the facility.

Citizens can register online or here at the jail facility by asking for and completing a Clackamas County Jail Visitor Visitation Request form.

Once approved citizens can call ahead and arrange for an appointment to visit inmates. When it's time to visit, you simply show up at the Clackamas County Jail and check-in.

This new system of visitation will give citizens more opportunity for visiting loved ones and friends who are in jail.

The Clackamas County Jail Video Visitation is open seven days a week.

Staff on duty are expected to adhere to policy as are all visitors.

Please do not ask staff to make exceptions in the enforcement of this policy.

Inmate visiting is based on classification and housing assignment. Inmates must be in the facility for 72 hours before they are allowed visitation. Individuals in disciplinary segregation are not allowed visitors. Below is the visiting schedule.

The Jail reserves the right to cancel visiting at any time. There are those occurrences when the inmate is not available for visiting (i.e. medical appointment, court, technical difficulties, etc.). In these instances the visitor will be told that the inmate is unavailable for visiting. The jail is not responsible for rescheduling visits.

GENERAL VISITING DAYS AND TIMES

Visiting Hours are as follows each day:

8:00 A.M. - 10:30 A.M.

2:30 P.M. - 4:30 P.M.

7:00 P.M. - 9:30 P.M.

The end time of each session is the time that all visits are to be completed

ADMINISTRATIVE VISITING TIMES

Times vary for those inmates in Administrative Detention. Visitation is subject to times scheduled for their housing assignment

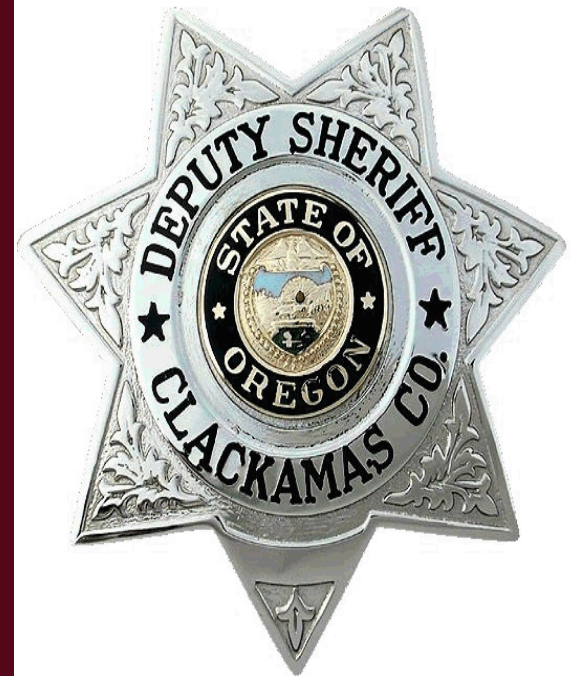

REGISTERING AND SCHEDULING A VISIT BY INTERNET

1. Go to the internet site:
<http://videovisweb.clackamas.us>
2. Click on the "Register Today" button and follow the instructions.
3. Using the password and username created in step 2, log in to enter the website for scheduling.
3. Visitation must be scheduled 3 days in advanced.
4. Arrive 15 minutes prior to scheduled appointment time and check-in.

All inmate visits are 25 minutes in duration

While the preferred method is internet, you can also schedule in person or by telephone.

HOW TO SCHEDULE A VISIT BY PHONE

1. Contact the Clackamas County Jail at **503-722-6575** between the hours of 10:30 and Noon. You must register yourself online or complete The Clackamas County Jail Visitor Visitation Request form.
2. Request a date and available times for visiting will be given. Obtain appointment confirmation from staff. Arrive 15 minutes prior to scheduled appointment time.

VISITATION RULES

- 1. All visits at home over the internet and at the Jail must follow the same rules.**
2. Visitation is by appointment only. Appointments may be scheduled up to one week in advance, but no less than 3 days in advance.
3. Each inmate is permitted a maximum of four visitors per week. Each visitor can only visit twice per week.
4. All visitors must properly identify themselves upon arriving at the jail. (Visitors must have a government issued photo ID indicating their date of birth,
5. All visitors will maintain a calm, quiet, and orderly demeanor for the entire length of the visit.
- 6. Visitors arriving after the start of their scheduled session will not be allowed to visit.**
7. Visitors appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted into visiting.
8. Proper attire is required at all times. Any attire that is worn in an overly sexually provocative manner, or that is associated with gang apparel, is sensational, dangerous, or could be viewed as offensive in nature is prohibited.
9. The parent or legal guardian of a minor child must maintain close supervision of that child before, during and after each visit. Children will never be left unattended for any reason.
- 10. Smoking is prohibited inside the Jail visitation Lobby.**
11. Minor children who are less than twelve (12) years of age, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of eighteen (18) years during their visit. There is a limit of 2 minor children and one adult at a time in a visitation station.
12. All minor children will count as a visitor. Minors over the age of 12 years of age will visit without a parent or guardian present in the visiting area.
- 13. All visitors including minors must be scheduled to visit. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to schedule appointments with minors under the age of 12. If the minors under the age of 12 are not listed or scheduled for a visit with the parent or guardian they will not be allowed to visit that day.**
14. Inmates will be allowed only one adult visitor or minor over the age of 12 in the visiting area at one time.
15. No visitor will be allowed to visit an inmate until a thorough background check has been performed. A negative background check will bar a visitor from seeing an inmate.
16. No persons will be allowed to visit who are not listed, or who have been listed incorrectly, on the inmates visiting list.
17. Visitors who turn in a visiting list will not be allowed visits for the first seventy-two (72) hours (or longer depending upon circumstances).
- 18. Any use of electronic devices such as cell phones, camera, computer or electronic devices not being used to facilitate the visit are strictly prohibited.**

Violation of any of the above regulations may result in the conclusion of the visit and/or suspension of future visitation privilege.
