# Adult in Custody Video Visitation

The Clackamas County Jail's top priority is the safety and security of everyone in the facility.

Citizens can register online at <a href="https://www.gettingout.com">www.gettingout.com</a> to set up a visitation account. From the website you can schedule visits or utilize the Visit Now function to visit with an adult in custody when convenient. Visits will only be able to take place during established visiting hours.

This new system of visitation will give citizens more opportunity for visiting loved ones and friends who are in jail.

The Clackamas County Jail Video Visitation is open seven days a week.

Staff on duty are expected to adhere to policy as are all visitors.

Please do not ask staff to make exceptions in the enforcement of this policy.

Adult in custody visiting is based on classification and housing assignment. Individuals in disciplinary segregation are not allowed visitors. Below is the visiting schedule.

The Jail reserves the right to cancel visiting at any time. There are those occurrences when the adult in custody is not available for visiting (i.e. medical appointment, court, technical difficulties, etc.). In these instances the visitor will be told that the adult in custody is unavailable for visiting. The jail is not responsible for rescheduling visits.

### GENERAL VISITING TIMES

Visiting Hours are as follows each day:

8:00 A.M. - 10:30 A.M. 2:30 P.M. - 4:30 P.M. 7:00 P.M. - 9:30 P.M.

The end time of each session is the time that all visits are to be completed

#### ADMINISTRATIVE VISITING TIMES

Times vary for those in Administrative
Detention. Visitation is subject to times scheduled for
their housing assignment



RULES & REGULATIONS



### **HOW TO VISIT**

- 1. Go to the internet site: www.gettingout.com
- 2. Click on the "Create Account" button and follow the online instructions to create your account.
- You will be able to schedule visits online through the website.
- You can also use the Visit Now feature to visit with an adult in custody right away, provided it is during general visiting hours.

# All visits are offered in 15 minute increments

Each adult in custody will receive 2 free visits per week

### VISITATION RULES

- 1. All visits at home over the internet and at the Jail must follow the same rules.
- All visitors must properly identify themselves upon arriving at the jail. (Visitors must have a government issued photo ID indicating their date of birth.
- **3.** All visitors will maintain a calm, quiet, and orderly demeanor for the entire length of the visit.
- 4. Visitors appearing to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted into visiting.
- 5. Proper attire is required at all times.
  Any attire that is worn in an overly sexually provocative manner, or that is associated with gang apparel, is sensational, dangerous, or could be viewed as offensive in nature is prohibited.
- 6. The parent or legal guardian of a minor child must maintain close supervision of that child before, during and after each visit. Children will never be left unattended for any reason.
- 7. Smoking is prohibited inside the Jail visitation Lobby.

8. Minor children who are less than twelve (12) years of age, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of eighteen (18) years during their visit.

There is a limit of 2 minor children and one adult at a time in a visitation station.

- 9. All minor children will count as a visitor. Minors over the age of 12 years of age will visit without a parent or guardian present in the visiting area.
- **10.** Adults in custody will be allowed only one adult visitor or minor over the age of 12 in the visiting area at one time.
- 11. Any use of electronic devices such as cell phones, camera, computer or electronic devices not being used to facilitate the visit are strictly prohibited.
- 12. The jail reserves the right to run background checks on visitors and remove visitors at any time.

Violation of any of the above regulations may result in the conclusion of the visit and/or suspension of future visitation privilege.
