# Main Street 3D Downtown Program



Clackamas County Economic Development will provide to its Main Street communities 3D Downtown services with the goal to spur private investment, increase property values, retain and recruit business, and enhance the appearance of downtowns by creating mock up architectural renderings. With over 20 years of Architectural and planning experience in the Portland Metro Area, Clackamas County has hired DECA Architecture to provide this service for our communities.

- Clackamas County Main Street communities are eligible to apply for 3D modeling services through Clackamas County Economic Development valued up to \$5,000
- Eligible projects include exterior building improvements and restorations, infill or redevelopment projects, and high density, mixed-use, or multi-family projects
- Clackamas County community partners must submit an application for review and approval by Clackamas County Economic Development staff
- Upon approval of the Application, the assigned architects work with the local community and property owner to render the 3D design and estimate the financial feasibility

#### **Eligibility**

- Exterior building improvements and restorations on private and publically owned properties
- Infill or redevelopment projects (no larger than one city block)
- High-density mixed-use and multi-family residential projects
  - This project is **not** intended for interior improvements.
  - Single-family residential projects are not eligible.
  - Exclusive public projects are not eligible.
- Clackamas County Community Partners and Economic Development professional staff must submit their applications with the approval of business and property owners.

#### **Guidelines**

- The 3D Downtown Program offers 3D modeling services for downtown improvement with a value of up to \$5,000 per project provided by the architecture firm on retainer by Clackamas County Economic Development
- Eligible communities must submit an application subject to review and approval by Clackamas County staff
- Grants are awarded as funding is available on a first-come, first-serve basis
- Funds are limited to one grant per community per fiscal year
- Projects must be located within the defined boundary of Clackamas County downtown districts
- Proposed projects must preserve and enhance architectural integrity of historic buildings and/or historic districts
- The applicant and the property owner must both sign the application and agreement and must comply with the conditions of the program
- Materials submitted with the application will not be returned unless specifically requested
- Clackamas County Main Street may use the completed designs and cost analyses for promotional purposes and/or materials
