Geographic Burden of Overdoses in Clackamas County




In Clackamas County, Eagle Creek and Estacada experience the highest rates of overdose fatalities. These communities have much smaller population sizes compared to some of the other cities in the county and are in very rural communities, which likely have a longer response time from 911 services due to farther distances for EMS to travel. Milwaukie, Happy Valley and Oregon City have the highest raw numbers of overdose fatalities. See the map and table below to see which communities have higher rates of overdose fatalities.

Milwaukie, Oregon City and Happy Valley continue to be the cities in Clackamas County with the highest number of overdose-related 911 calls. These cities overlap in both the fatality data and 911 data, proving to be the hardest hit areas for overdose.
