This Atlas Cedar is located within the Oak Grove unincorporated area of Clackamas County.

This tree species is not a native of the United States, but originated from Algeria and Morocco. This species is a medium-sized to large tree that can grow to 120 feet in height with a 40 foot canopy in its native environment and about half the size in a cultivated environment.

This tree is nominated and approved under the Heritage Tree category of specimen.
