JRP-23-03 GRANT AGREEMENT
AMENDMENT # 1
CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION
JUSTICE REINVESTMENT PROGRAM

This is Amendment No. 1 to Grant Agreement No. JRP-23-03 (“Agreement”) between the State of Oregon, acting through its Criminal Justice Commission (“CJC” or “State”), and **Clackamas County** (“Recipient”).

1. Effective Date. This Agreement shall become effective on the date that it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.

2. Amendment to Agreement. The Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

A. The Grant Amount and Completion Deadline in Section 1 are amended as follows:

Grant Amount: \$2,566,240

Completion Deadline: December 31, 2025

B. Section 3.A is amended and restated to include additional disbursements as follows:

A. Disbursement. Upon execution of this Agreement and satisfaction of all conditions precedent, CJC shall disburse Grant funds to Recipient in installments as listed:

(1) \$623,082 on January 5, 2024;

(2) \$623,082 on May 5, 2024;

(3) \$660,038 on September 5, 2024; and

(4) \$660,038 on January 5, 2025.

C. The Project Description and Project Period in Exhibit A are amended as follows:

Project Description:

The Justice Reinvestment Program supports Oregon counties in fulfilling the requirements of House Bill 3194 (2013), specifically to plan, implement, and expand initiatives that establish a process to assess individuals and provide a continuum of community-based sanctions, services, and programs.

The goals of CJC’s Justice Reinvestment Program include:

- Reducing recidivism through evidence-based practices while protecting public safety and holding individuals accountable; and
- Decreasing prison utilization for property, drug, and driving offenses while protecting public safety and holding individuals accountable.

Recipient shall base implementation of its Project on existing research and evidence-based practices, and use Grant funds to support the following program(s) in working toward the goals stated above:

Clackamas Substance Abuse Program, Short-Term Transitional Leave, and Clackamas County Jail Program.

Project Period:

Start Date: July 1, 2023

End Date: December 31, 2025

3. Counterparts. This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts (by facsimile or otherwise) each of which is an original and all of which when taken together are deemed one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.

4. Original Agreement. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of original Agreement remain in full force and effect. By its execution of this Amendment, Grantee certifies to CJC that the representations, warranties and certifications contained in the original Agreement are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.
