• If an organization is intentionally planning to use distance learning as their format for parenting education, they need to use a curriculum that was published with virtual education as the intent. Visiting curriculum publisher websites will be the best way to see if each program has developed an approved virtual delivery method. The list of programs that have approved virtual formats is likely updating constantly due to Covid-19 recommendations, organizations should do their own research to find the most current update for any program. Previously or commonly used virtual programs include Active Parenting Now, Triple P (Positive Parenting Program), and Parenting Wisely.
