### Which training to choose:

- Safety planning is included in Youth SAVE and ASIST – more safety planning in ASIST
- Youth SAVE assumes that you have a foundational understanding of suicide and empathetic listening and reflective conversations with youth
- Youth Save is about ½ the time as ASIST
- ASIST has a little more depth in safety planning
- Cross pollination with folx across the state through Youth SAVE (virtual delivery)
- Since ASIST is not available currently in the Metro area, highly recommend that if the Youth SAVE is appropriate for you, take it before the end of June (now)
- Folx commented that this training is very current, updated
- Waiting to see if there will be additional funds from OHA for trainings or trainers

4.	<b>Legislative Update on a handful of bills</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• HB 2315 – require BH professionals for continuing education in suicide prevention, assessment, treatment – recommended to pass, second reading, on the path to passing</li><li>• SB 568 – Adult Suicide Prevention Plan and Coordinator into statute –</li><li>• HB 3139 – just had hearing today; require parental notification when a youth is at imminent risk of suicide</li><li>• Another one - Change the notification of medical examiners</li></ul>	Jenn	5:20 pm
