Dear Oregon City View Manor Resident,

We want to update you on the status of the Housing Authority's application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requesting permission to sell Oregon City View Manor.

As you may recall, the application was submitted to HUD in December 2017. HUD responded to the application by requesting more information prior to moving forward.

It's important for you to know this request from HUD has pushed back this project for approximately six months. This means we will NOT be moving residents from Oregon City View Manor starting this June, so please do not make any plans to move from your home right now.

Once the additional information to HUD is provided and we receive approval to proceed, we will send you a letter with updated information and next steps.
