Entries are released at 8:00 AM Sunday August 18, 2019.

Specific Rules:

- Exhibitors should read General Rules and Regulations and Livestock Department Rules found on Clackamas County Fair website under Exhibitor Handbook.
- Bedding must be furnished by the exhibitor.
- All blowers that were manufactured with a prong plug must have a 3 prong plug to be used on the fair grounds.
- Tack pen space for all open livestock is limited.
- All cattle stalls and adjacent space must be kept neat and clean at all times. Failing to
 do so may result in forfeit of premium money and loss of participating in future years.
- All animals must be registered. Registration certificates must be presented to the Dairy Superintendent and will be checked prior to show time.
- To be eligible in a group class, an animal must also be shown as an individual.
- Group classes may be composed of animals kept on the same farm yet owned by different members of the family unit. Groups must be listed on the entry form.
- HALTER AND NECK ROPE ARE REQUIRED ON CATTLE AT ALL TIMES WHILE BEING STALLED.
