Rent increase reminders

Please remember that the Housing Contract requires that you notify the tenant AND the Housing Authority at least 60 days before any proposed rent increase. If the Housing Authority doesn't get a copy of the notice you sent to the tenant at least 60 days in advance we have to push the rent increase further out. We are also unable to do midmonth rent increases. Emailing the rent increases to Landlord Services works great, and you get an email confirmation.
