# **Oregon White Oak Grove #2**

Oak Grove #2 is centrally located with 12 individual trees that combine to create a massive canopy that extends 75 to 100 feet. The individual tree trunk diameters vary from 10 feet, 7 inches to 3 feet, 4 inches.

One tree has a chain link embedded in the trunk and another has a saw blade embedded in its trunk.

The grove provides a spectacular sight that is a significant landmark in the community. This second grove of Oregon White Oaks represents a classic oak savannah grove made up of a native species that once dominated the regional landscape.

This grove of Oregon White Oak trees qualifies under the heritage tree historic, landmark and collection criteria.
