REQUEST: Staff is seeking Board approval to establish a Task Group comprised of a range of stakeholders to provide input and guidance as we develop a Recovery Center for people with substance abuse disorders.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the Board's directive, staff have been working on developing a Recovery Center for the past several months. At the April 10, 2024 Policy Session, staff briefed the Board on current activities and those planned in the upcoming months. One such activity is the creation of a Task Group to:

- To provide input and guidance to staff on the development of the Recovery Center for people with substance use disorders. Information from the Task Group will be included in Board updates.
- To identify issues of concern, barriers, etc. and help problem-solve them.
- To collaborate across systems and partners to develop an accessible, person-centered set of services that are responsive to individuals, families, and communities.
- To help communicate and educate stakeholders.

Attached is a draft Charter and list of organizations and agencies recommended to be included on the Task Group. Please note that provider agencies are not listed due to a potential conflict of interest as we will be discussing requirements of the NOFO (Notice of Funding Opportunity).
