Pam has a lot of questions regarding the purpose of the bill and is having a hard time understanding the details. ➤ Measure110: apparently funding for BHRN's may be reduced due to low revenue. Lack of transparency in the oversight committee. ➤ Bills will start dying and we will get a clearer picture of what to focus on. ➤ 988 telecom tax to fund the 988 call center run by line for life. Hope is the that this tax will help fund mobile crisis services. However, now it is just focusing on the call center. ➤ Nominating Committee - All paperwork is up with the BCC for final approval and appointment. ➤ Suicide Prevention Coalition of Clackamas County Update - review apps (youth) read updates from Donna-Marie. ➤ Director Update - Mary advised that as a county we have applied for funding to work force retention and supervision for licensed professionals.
