

In-Custody Property

If you were arrested by the Sheriff's Office, any property identified as "safe keeping" (large items, backpacks, and/or other items not accepted by the jail) must be picked up at the Sheriff's Office Property Room. If you were arrested by another agency you will need to contact that agency.

Property seized as evidence is held until your criminal case is resolved. 30 days after your criminal case is resolved some property may be released. If you provided, your name and address to the arresting deputy, you should receive a letter notifying you to make an appointment to retrieve your property.

Pick up of property is by appointment only.

SIGNS OF AN OPIOID OVERDOSE



Skin feels cold and clammy



Fingernails or lips are blue or purple



Body is very limp



Can't wake the person up



Deep snoring or gurgling sounds



Breathing is very slow, erratic or has stopped



Pupils are very small

Narcan can help temporarily reverse an opioid overdose. If you suspect an overdose, **CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY.**
