Community Planning Organizations - Get to know and shape your community If you live in unincorporated Clackamas County, a Community Planning Organization (CPO) is a great way to have a voice in the livability of your community! These organizations are run by volunteers — your neighbors and friends — who care about community challenges and growth issues where you live. They welcome participation by everyone in the organization's area.

Some reasons you might want to get involved in your CPO

- Meet other people in your community. In addition to working on growth and development matters, some organizations plan fun holiday events, festivals and other gatherings.
- Know about land use projects that are being proposed in your area. If you heard a rumor about something going on in your community, your CPO is a great place to go to learn more.
- Participating in a community organization is an easy, no-pressure way to have a voice and connection with your county government.

Community Planning Organizations are advisory to the Board of County Commissioners, the Planning Department, and the Planning Commission on matters affecting their areas. They may develop neighborhood plans and proposals concerning land use, zoning, parks, open space and recreation, annexation, housing, community facilities, transportation and traffic, community services, and other factors affecting the livability of their areas.
