POLICY QUESTION

Shall the Emergency Management Department continue to apply for financial support through FEMA's Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG)?

ISSUE & BACKGROUND

The EMPG is a recurring federal grant program providing limited reimbursement of a portion of the costs incurred in operating local emergency management programs. The funds are provided for the development of an all-hazard emergency management capability to promote preparedness, mitigation, response and recovery.

EMPG allocations for 2010 have not yet been confirmed, but the allocation for Clackamas County is estimated at \$210,000.

The Oregon Office of Emergency Management requires an annual EMPG Work Plan comprised of mandatory work plan elements defined by the State, as well as elective elements selected by the County. Timely completion of Work Plan objectives is the primary grant performance measure. The Emergency Management Department submits EMPG activity and financial reports to the state, receiving allocated reimbursement on a quarterly basis.

The 2010 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) agreement between the County and the Oregon Office of Emergency Management requires Board approval.

QUESTION(S) PRESENTED FOR CONSIDERATION

Does the 2010 EMPG Work Plan accurately reflect Clackamas County Emergency Management program priorities?

OPTIONS AVAILABLE

- Approve the 2010 EMPG Work Plan and Agreement. Successful accomplishment of Work Plan objectives will result in an estimated savings of \$210,000 in General Fund contributions to the Emergency Management Department.
- 2. Direct Emergency Management Department staff to revise the Work Plan.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Board approval of the 2010 EMPG Work Plan and Agreement.
