WHAT ACTION ARE YOU REQUESTING FROM THE BOARD?

The purpose of this policy & planning session is to seek preliminary approval of the revised fee schedule for the H3S / Public Health Division's Environmental Health Program for inclusion in FY 2015-16 budget proposals.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Environmental Health Program is proposing to raise fees. Current fees set in FY 2006-07 no longer cover the costs to provide services. Early review and preliminary provisional approval of proposed fees allows County departments to integrate those proposals into the FY 2016 budget request.

A summary of changes are described in the attachments. The H3S / Public Health Division's Environmental Health Program is proposing revisions due to the following:

- Fees have not increased since FY 2006-07 due to the recession.
- The program has exhausted all of its fund balance and is now using County General Fund to cover the deficit.
- The biggest proposed increases are due to adjusting the amount of time for inspection charged. In 2012, inspection requirements were revised and new rules added which increased the time need to conduct each inspection.

The Environmental Health Program fees are calculated from an hourly rate based on a costing formula that is commonly used by counties across the state. The current hourly rate for services is \$118, set in FY 2006-07. The proposed hourly rate is \$138, a 14% increase.

Over half of the proposed fee increases are below the estimated 18% increase in COLA expenses over time since FY 2006-07; the remaining increases are set according to cost per State guidance.

The Environmental Health program is staffed with 5 full-time inspectors, 1 supervisor, and 1 clerical support staff member. In 2014 the department completed over 3000 inspections.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS (current year and ongoing):

In FY 2015 the program budgeted \$834,376 in revenue. For FY 2016 the fees will increase revenue by \$128,279. FY 2016 the proposed budget revenue is \$963,655.

Denying the rate increase will require the H3S / Public Health Division to subsidize program costs from County General Fund allocations. This will require the Division to make reductions in other portions of its budget to offset costs.

FY 2016-17 and thereafter, we propose approval of an additional annual increase to account for COLA expenses, with a full fee review every three years.

LEGAL/POLICY REQUIREMENTS:

Oregon statute (ORS 624.510) requires local jurisdictions to collect fees that are adequate to cover the administration and enforcement costs incurred by the local public health authority and the cost of oversight by the Oregon Health Authority / State of Oregon.

The Board of County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Health for Clackamas County, establishes fees as part of the annual budget adoption process.
