EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Clackamas County received funds from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. The Board approved funds of \$10.1 million dollars for the expansion of broadband into rural, underserved areas of Clackamas County. The Board directed CBX to procure needed materials to complete the fiber expansion into approved areas. This materials request will be the final materials order to complete the broadband expansion in Clackamas County for the ARPA funds.

PROCUREMENT PROCESS:

This project advertised in accordance with ORS and LCRB rules on October 21, 2024. Bids were received on November 5, 2024. The project received a total of eight (8) bids: Kyle Enterprises; Adams Cable; Telecom Surplus; General Pacific; Graybar; Power & Telephone Supply Company; and Managed Data Associates. Bidders were allowed to bid on one or multiple individual groupings of listed products. After a review of the bids, Telecom Surplus Resources, Inc was the lowest bidder.

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RECOMMENDATION:

Staff respectfully recommends that the Board approve this purchase with Telecom Surplus Resources, Inc.
