Reviewed some key areas that the state maybe making reductions in funding to. ➤ CARES act funding is not to be used to fill budget deficit. Currently there is a 3 Billion dollar deficit. ➤ She advised that the Senior Loneliness Line would be going statewide. ➤ Mary advised that the "GO Teams" are going to food distribution sites.
