### **Significant Features**

Adjacent to Wildcat Mountain Road with a spectacular canopy that overhangs the road.

It exists as a community icon.

## **Oregon White Oak**

This Oregon White Oak is located on farmland and along SE Horseshoe Drive in Eagle Creek.

The tree species is slow growing and at maturity can reach up to 70 feet with a lifespan of 95 to 135 years.

The exact age of the tree is unknown, but is believed to be approximately 100 years old. The tree is approximately 80 feet high with a 96-foot canopy — larger than the typical specimen.
