Explanatory Statement

Approval of this measure would prohibit the establishment and operation of psilocybin-related businesses within Oregon City.

Ballot Measure 109, passed in 2020, allows the manufacture, delivery, and administration of psilocybin at licensed facilities within the state. State law allows local governments to adopt an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin related businesses within the city, but the council must refer the ordinance to the voters at a statewide general election. The Oregon City Commission has adopted an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of psilocybin related businesses within the city and, as a result, has referred this measure to the voters. If approved, this measure would prohibit psilocybin-related businesses within the city.
