Background and Purpose

In response to the Coronavirus public health crisis, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136 was signed into law on March 27, 2020 to help respond to the coronavirus outbreak. The CARES Act allocated additional Community Development Block Grant COVID funding for Clackamas County to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

The purpose of the NOFO is for the Clackamas County Health, Housing and Human Services Department's Community Development Division ("CDD") to partner with community based organizations ("CBO") to assist eligible low-income County residents impacted by COVID-19 with health care services and homeless shelter and services.

All COVID Projects and contract funding levels were determined in coordination with the County's COVID 19 Emergency Operations Center activated on February 28, 2020. The intent of these funded projects will be to reduce the spread of COVID-19 and to reduce the economic and health impacts on low-income households in Clackamas County.

Funding Recommendations

A total of six (6) proposals were submitted. All were reviewed and evaluated in the context of other available and awarded state and federal funding for these types and projects and services in Clackamas County. Funding agreements and other related contracts will be reviewed and approved by the Board of County Commissioners.
